## FEEDING INSTRUCTIONS

ADULT DOGS - Adult dogs are fed usually only once a day. Their requirement is 30 to 45 calories per day per pound of body weight. Use the feeding chart below to determine an approximate measure of food for your dog. Age and activity levels should help you determine the exact amount of food your dog needs. Sometimes a larger less active dog requires less food or calories than a smaller breed of dog that is more active. All dogs and puppies must have access to fresh, clean water at all times. Food and water containers should be washed daily.

## A STANDARD 8 FLUID OUNCE MEASURING CUP HOLDS APPROXIMATELY 4 OUNCES OF MARTIN'S FORMULA DOG FOOD.

For pregnant dogs and puppies, feed approximately 1 $1 / 2$ times the amount indicated. Allow her to eat 2 to 3 times this level during the peak of her lactation.
